INSTRUCTIONS

WHO MUST FILE. Every person operating a motor fuels pipeline terminal facility in Nebraska must file a Nebraska Motor Fuels Terminal Operator Report, Form 87, with the appropriate Schedule of Receipts and Schedule of Disbursements. The required data must be filed via electronic data interchange (EDI).

WHEN TO FILE. This report and appropriate schedules must be transmitted by the 20th of the month following the month covered by this report.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

LINE 1. Total from line 7 of the previous month.

LINE 2. Receipts of products imported through pipeline and transport. Receipts are reported in net gallons.

LINE 4. All disbursements must be reported in gross gallons.

PENALTY. A penalty of \$50 will be imposed on delinquent reports filed within 10 days after the due date. An additional penalty of \$100 will be imposed on reports filed more than 10 days after the due date.

RECORDS. The records required to substantiate this report must be retained and available for at least three years, or five years if the required reports are not filed.
